


MONTIS



MONTIS is a very high yielding, medium early variety with a yellow flesh color. Due to its very long uniform tubers and excellent frying texture it is well suited for the production of French Fries.

Some interesting facts about MONTIS:

- Resistance against nematodes Ro 1, 4 (9)
- Resistance against wart disease 1 (10), 6 (slightly susceptible)
- Good tolerance to periods of drought and heat
- High number of big sized tubers
- Very high resistance to hollow heart
- Homogenous tuber shape and size
- Well suited for long term storage with excellent frying colors
- Consistently very high yield with low nitrogen input
- High tolerance against *Phytophthora infestans*



MATURITY:	medium early
TUBER SHAPE:	long shape with shallow eyes, yellow skin and flesh color
PROCESSING:	Ideally suited for the processing of French Fries, mealy cooking type
YIELD:	very high
